Following successful formalisation of the Woodilee Residents Association, the committee have met on a quarterly basis to discuss issues raised by residents and find acceptable resolutions.

WHAT DOES THE RESIDENTS ASSOCIATION DO?

The association represents the majority view of the residents to the factor, RMG, and to the consortium. We provide a voice that is listened to, pursue value for money and contribute valuable feedback on decisions regarding our development.

Some of the current successes and upcoming projects include:

- The installation of bird and bat boxes within the woodland, in adherence with the Habitat Plan
- Completion of remedial works to the main spine culvert with the consortium agreeing to cover the costs
- The provision of additional litter bins
- The provision of additional grit bins and planned relocation of existing grit bins to better service the whole estate
- Overseeing and monitoring matters that have been raised for the consortium to resolve
- Provided a central conduit for expressing views to RMG
- Developed an effective and professional working relationship with RMG
- The installation of LED street lighting
- Developed a phased plan approach for the provision of additional drainage measures throughout the site in response to resident concerns
- The proposed installation of interpretation boards to highlight pathways, wildlife and habitats found across
 the estate
