Aldi UK – Kirkintilloch

I would like to take this opportunity to update you on our plans for our proposed store at Initiative Road/McGavigans Road, Kirkintilloch.

The Proposals

Our proposals would involve the development of a modern food store that will serve the communities of Kirkintilloch, Lenzie and Woodilee along with the surrounding area. Local residents and all those with an interest in the proposals are able to find out more about their plans, and importantly provide valuable feedback, at www.aldiconsultation.co.uk/kirkintilloch.

On Monday 11th January 2021, we hosted a Live Online Consultation Event between 6pm and 8pm for local residents to provide feedback to our team and allow us the opportunity to answer any queries. Despite sending leaflets to over 2,000 residents in the vicinity of the site, it was brought to our attention that some streets adjacent to the site were unfortunately missed. As such we are planning to host another event on **Tuesday 26th January 2021 between 6.00pm and 7.30pm. If you would like to attend please see overleaf details on how to access the webinar on Zoom.**

The opportunity for members of the public to provide feedback will remain open until 15th February 2021, and this can be undertaken either through the dedicated website as above, or by returning the freepost form which is enclosed. Following the online consultation, we hope to lodge a planning application with East Dunbartonshire Council in the early part of the year with the new store welcoming shoppers as early as Christmas 2022, subject to planning. The proposed store will deliver a 1,820 sqm food store, 1,254sqm sales floor, with 93 parking bays (inc. 76 standard, 7 parent and child, 6 disabled and 4 electric vehicle) and 8 cycle spaces.

How to Join the Consultation event:

1. If you are on a computer, type the following into your address bar of a web browser:

Alternatively, please follow the below instructions:

2. On a computer or mobile device there are two options (preferred method):
 - a. Start the Zoom application.
 - b. Click 'Join'.
 - c. Enter the meeting ID of **850 7306 3875** and your name, then click join.
 - d. You will enter the meeting and will be able to both see and hear the project team but will not be able to speak or be seen using your webcam.
3. Phoning into the event:
 - a. Dial **0131 460 1196**.
 - b. Enter the meeting ID of **850 7306 3875** followed by the # key.
 - c. You will join the meeting.
